## **What have we accomplished?**

- ✓ Six new ceiling fans were purchased and installed. Thank you to our Maintenance Committee (Carl Thomas & Melanie Haldren) along with Mike Cummings & Tom Fargo.
- ✓ The Pepsi machine & unused pop were returned to the vendor and credited to our account.
- ✓ A laptop was purchased to allow for web bill pay. It holds all relevant Town Hall files and will be passed from one Board to the next. This will give a new Board immediate access to the centralized, critical Town Hall files and communications.
- ✓ A Bulletin Board was purchased to improve communication. It will be placed by the flagpole around the commemorative bricks.
- ✓ Lawn care was put out for bid. A contract will be awarded by April 30, 2011.
- ✓ The window repair/replacement project was put out for bid. The committee is investigating repairing the existing window and/or replacing the windows entirely. Contracts will be award on or before May 31, 2011. Thank you to our Window Committee: Jim Roesch, Karl Schmidlin & Stan Gephardt.
